Closure on 26 December and 1 January

The SDA has applied to the Queensland Industrial Relations Commission for the closure of all non-exempt stores in Queensland on 26 December, 2010 and 1 January, 2011. These two days are not gazetted public holidays.

The object of the application is to achieve for members, adequate recuperation and quality family time after the busy pre-Christmas trading period, and the enjoyment of the Holiday season to no less an extent than that taken for granted by the community generally.

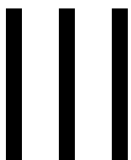
Obviously, the application will be vigorously opposed by the major retailers, and it is essential that we have at our disposal a significant volume of witness evidence to fully support our case.

We ask that you seriously consider giving evidence at the hearing before the Commission. We have a very short period of time within which to lodge our witness statements, and **your urgent attention to this matter is requested.**
